



Essa Khan's Journey: From False Accusations to Freedom

Karachi, originally from Peshawar. Essa was the sole provider for his family of five, earning Rs. 30,000 a month.

His life took a dark turn when he was falsely accused of carrying an unlicensed weapon and interfering with police work.

Despite having only Rs. 20,000 on him, Essa was arrested after a police party demanded a bribe of Rs. 100,000.

He was blindfolded, taken to an unknown location, and even shot in the leg. His family, living hand to mouth, could not afford a private advocate.

Meet Essa Khan, a 34-year-old laborer from Luckily, the Committee for the Welfare of Prisoners, assigned Mr. Khalid Hussain Shah to his case.

> After a long trial, during which many discrepancies in the case were highlighted, Essa was declared innocent.

> He was finally released on January 24, 2024, proving that justice can prevail even in the face of adversity.
