Mazhar Ali: A Fight against Injustice

Mazhar Ali, a 25-year-old laborer from Sukkur, found himself in a nightmare when he was falsely arrested and imprisoned in Central Prison, Sukkur.

With a meager income of Rs. 10,000 per month supporting his five siblings, Mazhar could not afford a private advocate to defend him.

Accused of narcotics possession, Mazhar was arrested without proper evidence. Fortunately, Mr. Amjad Gabol, an advocate of the Committee for the Welfare of Prisoners, took up his case.

During the legal proceedings, several discrepancies were exposed, including the violation of the law in handling the case property and the absence of eyewitnesses to his alleged crime.

After a year-long legal battle, Mazhar was declared innocent, and he was released on January 30, 2024. His story is a testament to the importance of legal aid in ensuring justice for all, regardless of their financial circumstances.
