## Breaking Free: Muhammad Zubair's Journey from False Accusation to Acquittal!

Muhammad Zubair, a 33-year-old laborer from Sanghar, was the main provider for his family, earning Rs. 15,000 monthly.

Supporting two dependents, he struggled financially. Falsely implicated in a drug possession case, he was imprisoned in District Prison, Sanghar.

Despite their financial constraints, Zubair's family couldn't afford a private advocate. Thankfully, his case was referred to the Committee for the Welfare of Prisoners by the District and Sessions Judge, Sanghar.

Represented by advocate Mr. Hussain Bux Chang, Zubair's case began on 10th October, 2023. Upon conclusion, the court found multiple inconsistencies in the prosecution's case, including delays in evidence submission, conflicting police testimonies, and discrepancies in drug quantities.

Unable to prove his guilt beyond doubt, the prosecution failed, resulting in Zubair's exoneration by the court.

After enduring false accusations, Zubair was released on 2nd February, 2024, after 3 months and 24 days of wrongful imprisonment, finally achieving justice.
